As of April 1, 2011, the United Way of Greater Simcoe County (UWGSC) will officially launch itself as a Community Impact United Way.

By mid-November 2010 you will find our new Community Grant Application on our website, along with a Funding Guidebook to help your agency complete the funding application. The look of the application might look somewhat familiar but the expectations are a little different. The UWGSC will now require that Funded Partners measure the outcome and impact of the programs/projects UW dollars fund. Further, we will require that all Funded Partners play an active role in all areas of the UWGSC Annual Campaign.

This is a competitive process which will consider single-year, one-time requests and multi-year (to a maximum of three years at \$60,000 per annum) requests.

We will host a workshop on how to complete the application. We ask that you register for the workshop in advance.
